Parents Must Initial each line:

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	Drop off and pick up for School's Out is at the Hamilton Area YMCA JKR Branch.			
	You may drop your child off between $7:30 - 8:30$ a.m., and you must sign your child in. Any child who is not signed in by $8:30$ a.m. may miss the bus.			
	You may pick your child up between 4:30 - 5:30 p.m. You must sign your child out. The pick up person must be listed on the School's Out registration form and must bring identification.			
	Children must be picked up by 5:30 p.m. Parents who do not pick their child up by 5:30 p.m. will be charged \$15.00 for up to the first ten minutes they are late and \$2.00 per minute after that.			
	All campers must bring a brown bag lunch. All lunches must be peanut/nut free, disposable and labeled with the child's name.			
	You may send your child with souvenir money. The money should be placed in an envelope with the child's name and be given to the counselor, so they can assist your child in the gift shop.			
	Your child should not bring any toys or games from home. The Hamilton Area YMCA is not responsible for lost or stolen items.			
	Please do not send your child with a book bag. Most destinations do not allow bags.			
	Children must behave appropriately while at the destination and on the bus. The child must stay with his/her counselor at all times. Failure to follow the rules may result in suspension from the program.			
	If your child needs to receive medication during the program (including an EpiPen, inhaler, or			

non-prescription medication), you must fill out the bottom of the application form.
