OUR MISSION

We are a charitable organization dedicated to building a healthy spirit, mind, and body. Part of a world-wide movement, we put Christian principles into practice through programs that promote good health, strong families, youth leadership, community development, and international understanding. YMCAs are open to men, women, and children of all ages, incomes, abilities, races, and religions.

OUR CAUSE

The Y is a cause-driven organization that is for youth development, for healthy living and for social responsibility. We believe a strong community can only be achieved when we invest in our kids, our health and our neighbors.

OUR HISTORY

What started as a loose coalition of like-minded individuals in 1951 is now the largest community organization in Hamilton Township. Originally operating in program sites like schools and churches, a temporary facility was erected in 1984 to better meet our goal of improving the community's health and well-being. Our current JKR Branch was opened in 1991, so we could better respond to a growing community need for the services and programs we provide. A second branch – the Sawmill Day Camp and Recreation Center – was created in 2002 to provide improved facilities for youth development programming. Today, the Hamilton Area YMCA is an organization of more than 14,000 members throughout Central New Jersey.

OUR FOCUS

We believe that positive change only comes about when we invest in our kids, our health and our neighbors. That's why our programs, events and community initiatives further the following goals:

Youth Development

Values and skills learned early are vital building blocks. Because of the Y, children and teens are realizing their potential, learning positive behaviors and exploring their unique talents and interests. That makes for confident kids today and engaged, contributing adults tomorrow.

Healthy Living

Being healthy means more than simply being physically active; it's maintaining a balanced spirit, mind and body. At the Y, people of all ages are working toward that balance by challenging themselves to learn new skills and hobbies, engaging in activities outside their comfort zones and fostering connections with family and friends.

Social Responsibility

We know that when we work as one, we move people and communities forward. The Y is committed to supporting our neighbors and providing opportunities for kids, adults and families to embrace the spirit of volunteerism.

OUR REACH

The Hamilton Area YMCA's 14,000 members represent a diverse cross-section of Central New Jersey adults, children and families. Two-thirds of our members are from Hamilton Township, the state's 9th largest municipality. The other third hail from surrounding towns including Trenton, Robbinsville and East Windsor, and other Central New Jersey counties like Middlesex, Burlington and Ocean.

Y members range from children to active older adults from across the socio-economic spectrum. Some join simply for summer camp, while others visit the Y every day to participate in classes, activities and group meetings. Our membership is a reflection of the demographics of Central New Jersey, including many different races, creeds and abilities.

Capital Campaign Giving

In the next year, the Y will embark on a program to redevelop the Sawmill Day Camp and Recreation Center. The existing athletic fields have deteriorated over time, and drainage problems render them unplayable for days at a time after foul weather. At a time when the current inventory of athletic facilities in our area is not keeping up with the growing field of youth sports, we need to take action. Our kids need the type of facility that will be conducive to their safety and success. As part of the \$2.6 million Sawmill Improvement Project, the current fields will be transformed into a turf field athletic complex that will provide greater access to safe, high-quality facilities for sports leagues throughout Central New Jersey.
