DANCE STUDIO DRESS CODE

The studio has implemented a dress code to create a professional and organized environment. A neat and tidy appearance sets an attitude of attentiveness and respect for students and teachers. Teachers must be able to see the dancer's body outline clearly in order to make proper corrections on posture and alignment. Hair must be worn in a bun, ponytail, or styled off the face (with clips or a secure headband) so as not to obstruct the dancer's view. Tight fitting sweaters or cardigans may be worn if necessary. Hoodies are not permitted. Thank you for your cooperation!

Girls: All classes require a leotard and tights (any style or color). Ballet skirts may be worn for any ballet, preschool, or ballet combo class. Dance shorts or capris may be worn for any jazz, hip hop, tap, musical theatre, or tap or jazz combo class.

Boys: All classes require a t-shirt and shorts or tighter fitting sweat pants.

Studio Policies & Information

- The Hamilton Area YMCA dance program is a 9-month program running September May.
- Dance registration payments are due in full by November 21, 2018.
- Leotard, tights, and proper dance shoes are required. Please refer to our dress code for appropriate attire for your child's class. Tight fitting sweaters or cardigans may be worn if necessary. Hoodies are not permitted. Hair must be off the face and tied up securely during all dance classes. Jewelry (except stud earrings) is not permitted during class.
- Please make every effort to ensure your dancer is on time for his/her class. If you find yourself running late for class, please prepare/put on shoes in the hallway and have your child enter the classroom quietly. *Students will not be permitted to enter the class more than 15 minutes after the class has started. Once instruction has begun, the studio door should remain closed with the exception of late arrivals and emergencies. Your instructor will handle all shoe changes.*
- Parents must remain in the building at all times with children under 13 years old.
- Food and drinks are not permitted in the dance studio. This is for the safety of our dancers with severe allergies. (Students are permitted to bring water bottles into the studio unless it creates a distraction.)
- If your child misses a class, he/she is welcome to attend any other class in their age range as a make up. All make up classes must be attended by March 1, 2018. As we will be in preparation for the recital, no make ups will be permitted after this date.
- All class changes must be made by November 21, 2018.
- Costume payments must be made in full by November 21, 2018. A costume will not be ordered for your child until payment is made in full. Late payment will result in late ordering, and there is no guarantee that the costume will arrive in time for the recital. Costume fees range from \$50 - \$80. You will be notified of the exact amount in late October.
- Dancers will be measured during class for the recital costume.
- Dress rehearsal and the recital will be held in late April.
- Costume payments and recital ticket payments are non-refundable.
