K.I.N.D. Kids is a social skills program designed to teach children ages 7 - 9 to identify their spark and to recognize their spark champions. Children will learn to appreciate and accept the differences in one another, learn to respect and value themselves, discover the courage to be who they are and find their voice to stand up for others. Children will learn to exercise appropriate reactions to social challenges they face in everyday settings and will recognize and appreciate the power of kindness. Sessions are engaging, fun, age appropriate and interactive!
